Casino Hub and Spoke Tour

Day One: Arrive in Morgan City/Franklin at the hotel of your choice and freshen up for a fun-filled evening. Drive down to Charenton to the Cypress Bayou Casino, Louisiana's first land based casino. With over 1200 slots, 42 table games (including all your favorites: Black Jack, Craps, Let it Ride, Roulette and Texas Hold 'Em Bonus) and two great restaurants (including Café Bayou and Mr. Lester's Steakhouse), you're bound to enjoy Acadiana's loose and easy casino. A new addition is Shorty's, featuring slot machines, table games, off-track betting, a poker room; RIKRAK, an upscale Asian restaurant with sushi bar; Eddie's Grill, serving lunch and dinner; fresh, a coffee bar serving fresh baked pastry items as well as panini and salads, and Rox, an upscale nightclub featuring national entertainment. Overnight in Morgan City/Franklin.

Day Two: Spend the day at the Cajun Coast's first floating casino, The Amelia Belle. Overnight in Morgan City/Franklin.

Day Three: Today you'll travel to the Big Easy to Harrah's Casino. In the heart of the downtown area, you'll experience live jazz and Mardi Gras parades while playing your favorite slots and table games. Looking for a new spot in the afternoon or evening? Try Treasure Chest Casino in Kenner. Return to Morgan City/Franklin.
