### BOAT DESCRIPTIONS

**\*Please plan to arrive 30 minutes to your boat tour.**

#### Boat Tour #1 - Atchafalaya Basin Tour with John Burke

Cajun Riviera Tour de Swamp will tour into the Atchafalaya Basin to view the American Bald Eagle. The Atchafalaya Basin is the largest overflow swamp in the U.S. covering over 850,000 acres. The Basin includes 10 distinct aquatic & terrestrial habitats ranging from large rivers to backwater swamps. The Basin is most noted for its Cypress-Tupelo Gum swamp habitat and its Cajun heritage. The basin is home to over 170 bird species and is an important wintering ground for the birds of the Mississippi Flyway. Covered flat bottom boat. Bathroom on board. Maximum 20 people.

#### Boat Tour #2 - Bayou Black Tour with Billy Gaston (Available for Saturday afternoon only)

Billy Gaston, swamp tour operator of Cajun Man's Tours will journey into the backwater of Bayou Black, adding his special Cajun touch. This tour will meander through the old oil and gas canals where you will have the opportunity to see several birds of prey including, of course, Bald Eagles, Ospreys and various species of hawks. Other birds that are likely to be encountered include various species of ducks, wading birds and some song bird species. Great tour for families or groups. Covered flat bottom boat. Bathroom on board. Maximum 45 people.

**Boat Tour #3 - Turtle Bayou Tour with LUMCON**

Journey into Turtle Bayou to view Bald Eagles and get a glimpse of an eagle nest. This tour will also ride through natural bayous that provide for fantastic views and local wildlife. Other birds likely to be encountered include Anhingas, Double-crested Cormorants, Red-shouldered Hawks, White Ibis, Yellow-rumped Warblers, Carolina Chickadees and various species of terns and gulls. Two boats. Maximum 6 people on each boat.

**Boat Tour #4 - Bayou Long Tour with Captain Ivy**

The Bayou Long Tour includes various waterways including Lake Verret, Bayou Magazille, Four Mile Bayou, Grassy Lake, Bayou Cherami, Bayou Milhomme, and Lake Palourde. On this tour you will be able to view Bald Eagles and their nests, Blue Heron, Great Egret, Belted Kingfisher, White Ibis and various other species of birds. One boat. Maximum 8 people

**Boat Tour #5 – Bayou Teche National Wildlife Refuge (There is no fee for this boat tour.)**

The BTNWR in Franklin was established to provide critical habitat for the Louisiana black bear. The refuge provides a home for an abundance of wildlife including neotropical songbirds, wading birds, waterfowl, reptiles and amphibians. **You will probably NOT see eagles.** One boat. Max. (10) ppl

**Walking/Hiking Trail Bayou Teche National Wildlife Refuge - Friends of the Bayou Teche National Wildlife, Franklin Trail** - The Franklin Trail is a water front trail that will start at a flood protection pumping station in Franklin. Eagles and hawks are in the area. The trail is an old spoil bank from the Franklin canal dating back to 1950. It is covered with trees and wild life including blue herons, white herons, wood ducks, turtles, and alligators. Red maple may be in bloom **(There is no fee for this tour.)**

**Speakers**

Michael Seymour, "Status of Louisiana's Bald Eagles."

Michael Seymour, an Ornithologist for the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries Natural Heritage Program will discuss the Status of Louisiana's Bald Eagles.

Maggie McPherson, "Surfing the Heat Wave or the Green Wave: How Will Different Types of Migrants Track Seasonal Resources in a Changing Climate?" Maggie studied the annual migrations of five species of Kingbirds She will discuss implications, and tools that could be implemented for coarse-grained conservation plans.

Cathy DiSalvo, "Birds and How to Attract Them to Your Garden - Cathy DiSalvo will share tips for attracting birds to your home garden.

LSU Raptor Program - LSU Raptor Rehab receives approximately 1,800 wildlife cases each year at no cost to the people who bring them to the facility. While the goal is to release them back into the wild, non-releasable animals become teaching tools. Case studies and resident birds.
